INFECTION CONTROL & PREVENTION UPDATE



Back to Basics - Clean Habits, Healthy Home!

As summer winds down and routines shift, August is the perfect time to refresh our infection prevention practices. More visitors, back-to-school exposure, and seasonal changes can increase the risk of respiratory and gastrointestinal infections in long-term care. Let's take this opportunity to go back to basics and reinforce the everyday habits that keep our residents safe.

Hand Hygiene is Still Our #1 Defense

- Proper hand hygiene continues to be the most effective way to stop the spread of illness.
 - ✓Staff: Perform hand hygiene before and after resident contact, meals, and PPE use.
- Residents: Encourage handwashing before meals and after using the toilet.
 - ✓ Visitors: Use hand sanitizer at entry and exit points.

Cough & Cold Season Starts Early

- With increased visitor traffic and the return of school-aged family members, we may see an early rise in respiratory infections.
 - ✓ If you're sick, even mildly—stay home.
 - Masking is encouraged when symptoms are present, even if mild.
 - ✓ Report symptoms in resident's early
 - Clean and disinfect shared equipment
- Wipe down high-touch surfaces like door handles, dining tables, and handrails regularly.
- Encourage all departments to follow routine cleaning schedules.
