



Declaration: Expectations for Visiting The Elliott Community

By visiting a resident at The Elliott Community, I agree to abide by the following:

- Complete the required training prior to first visit.
- Review the Essential Visitor Policy and attest to reading the policy monthly.
- Be rapid tested during each visit, wait for your results before visiting your loved one.
- With the implementation of “Rapid Antigen Testing” you no longer need a weekly PCR test but this will change if any area of our home goes into outbreak.
- If you receive a positive Rapid Test you will be required to leave the facility and book an appointment at the testing center within 24 hours of your positive test.
- Please inform the assessment center that you tested positive on a Rapid Antigen Test that was conducted at The Elliott Community.
- When in outbreak, you will be required to resume a weekly PCR test and show proof of negative COVID test to the screener upon entry to the facility.
- Participate in active screening and temperature check and answer all screening questions upon entering as well as prior to exiting the building.
- Monitor yourself for symptoms of COVID-19 and ensure you do not visit and get a PCR test if feeling unwell.
- Practice hand hygiene upon entering the building, before exiting and frequently during my visit. Hand sanitizer is available throughout the building.
- **Wear the surgical mask and shield at all times (and other personal protective equipment if required) when inside the building. Ensure the mask covers your nose, mouth and chin at all times and avoid touching the mask unless you have first performed hand hygiene.**
- Wear an identification badge at all times that is clearly visible to staff.
- Maintain physical distance of two metres (six feet) between yourself and residents who you are not visiting as well as staff.
- Please refrain from bringing pets into the facility.
- **Consumption of food or beverages at any time during your visit is prohibited as this would require you to remove your shield and mask.**
- Food or beverages can be brought in from outside the home for consumption by the resident only.
- Use the washroom before visiting. If necessary, use the designated visitor washroom on the main floor or if visiting a retirement resident, you may use the washroom in resident suite if needed.
- If visiting a resident in the home area, I will:
 - Proceed directly to the resident's room / suite and visit only my loved one.

- If I am assisting the resident with a meal, I will assist them in their room.
- Be screened in when entering and screened out upon exiting the facility.
- If I enter or exit outside of regular screening hours I will be screened in and out by the Registered Staff.
- Follow all guidance from the Registered Staff
- If taking a resident to the court yard, I will:
 - Proceed directly to the courtyard and not visit other residents
 - Wear mask and shield at all time
 - Not consume food or drink.
- **When in the community, I will do my very best to practice hand hygiene, maintain physical distance, wear a mask in public spaces and limit my “social bubble”.**
